Simplification of requirements for export of industrial forestry products (wood and wood products) to cut cost and speed up the export process in order to promote and increase export of wood and wood products.

V-Legal is no longer a mandatory requirement for export, however Ministry of Environment and Forestry may issue V-Legal for export to the destination country who required the timber legality assurance, such as EU.

- The Government of Indonesia does not remove the Timber Legality Verification System (SVLK). MOT Regulation only simplifies the export requirements.
- **316 tariff lines** are classified as downstream/finished products, such as: pulp, plywood, etc.
- **44 tariff lines** are classified as intermediate product, products with certain technical criteria.
- Products classified as upstream/raw material are not allowed to be exported based on MOT Regulation No. Nomor 45/2019.
- Private sectors (upstream-downstream) are still required to have timber legality documents in the form of S-LK and S-PHPL (MOEF Regulation No. P.30/2016 and DG of Sustainable Production Forest Management Regulation No. P.14/2016).
